Description

Stokosept® wash is an alcohol- and soap-free hand cleanser for a hygienic handwash which complies with the requirements of EN 1499. Stokosept® wash is pH skin neutral and with its very good skin compatibility it is especially appropriate for frequent hand washing. Effectiveness against bacteria (EN 1040, EN 13727, EN 1499), certain viruses (EN 14476) and yeasts (EN 1275, EN 1650).

Perfume-free, clear, viscous, colourant-free liquid without alcohol.

Active substance: 16,0 mg/g Chlorhexidine digluconate (CAS-No. 18472-51-0)

Instructions for Use

Wet Hands. Rub 3 ml of undiluted Stokosept® wash into the hands following the standard rub-in method according EN 1499. Be sure that the hands are completely covered during the application time of 30 seconds. Thoroughly rinse off under running water and dry hands.

Using hygienic handwash preparations

Hand hygiene with water

-  rub hands palm to palm
-  rub right palm over left dorsum with interlaced fingers and vice versa
-  rub palm to palm with fingers interlaced
-  rub back of fingers to opposing palms with hands interlocked
-  rub thumbs rotationally (vice versa)
-  rotational rubbing with clasped fingers (vice versa)

After this rinse off thoroughly with water and dry hands.

Put antibacterial cleanser on to wet hands. The product must be allowed to act for a total of 30 seconds. Rub in the product following each of the steps illustrated above and repeating each action five times up to the wrists. Begin at step 1 again if the 30 seconds has not yet elapsed after step 6 and continue until the cleanser has been on the skin for the allotted time. Apply more of the product while cleaning the skin, as and when required. The skin must remain moist for the full contact time.



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
